## One Community Church

- Remember that every 01 person is important
  - 06 follow up plan
- Every call leads to the next 02 intentional interaction
- Have an intentional Guest Services follow up system

Have a data base automated

- Someone owns each person 03 until they're attached
- Upcoming memorable 08 moments
- Have mini-congregations available to attach people to
- A Pastor calls every person 09 taking a next step
- Attach to Bible study groups 05 and life groups
- Immediate classes for all 10 next steps

New people don't have a rhythm for church attendance. If you don't create a new rhythm quickly they return to their old life styles.
